

1) The word "church" (ἐκκλησία) means "called out from."

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<u>ἐκ</u> κλησία

ἐκ ⇒ "out of"

<u>κλησία</u> ⇒ "to be called"

"Church" = "the called out"

2) The church ⇒ people "called out of" the world and into a body of fellow believers.

2 Thessalonians 2:14

14 ... He called you by our gospel, ...

1 Peter 2:9

9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

2) The church ⇒ people "called out of" the world and into a body of fellow believers.

Ephesians 4:25

25 Therefore, putting away lying, "Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another.

3) Jesus promised to build (establish) only one such church (called-out-body).

Matthew 16:18

18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

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Ephesians 1:22-23

22 [God] put all things under [Jesus] feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church,

23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

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
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
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
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
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7) This body (church) was purchased by the blood of Christ.

Matthew 7:24-27

- 24 "Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock:
- 25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.
- 26 "But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand:
- 27 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall."

8) This body (church) was founded on the teachings of Christ.

1 John 2:3-5

- 3 Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.
- 4 He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
- 5 But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.

9) The apostles taught the same doctrine to every church.

Acts 2:42

42 And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers.

1 Corinthians 4:17

17 For this reason I have sent Timothy to you, who is my beloved and faithful son in the Lord, who will remind you of my ways in Christ, as I teach everywhere in every church.

10) A curse was placed upon anyone who would teach any other doctrine.

Galatians 1:8-9

- 8 But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.
- 9 As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

11) Since every congregation was organized by the same doctrine, every congregation was identical in doctrine and practice.

Luke 8:11

11 "Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.

Genesis 1:12

12 ... seed according to its kind, ...

- A corn seed ⇒ a corn plant.
- A wheat seed ⇒ a wheat plant.

12) The members of the church were forbidden to divide the church into different denominations.

1 Corinthians 1:10

10 Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be **no divisions** [denominations] **among you,** but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

13) Those causing divisions contrary to the doctrine of Christ were to be "marked and avoided."

Romans 16:17

17 Now I urge you, brethren, mark those who cause divisions and offenses, contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them.

14) The one church of Christ will always exist because it is produced by a "seed" ⇒ the word of God.

Luke 8:11

11 "... The seed is the word of God.

Matthew 24:35

35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.

Matthew 15:13-14

- 13 But He answered and said, "Every plant which My heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted.
- 14 Let them alone. They are blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind leads the blind, both will fall into a ditch."

Matthew 13

- 24 Another parable [Jesus] put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field;
- 25 but while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way.
- 26 But when the grain had sprouted and produced a crop, then the tares also appeared.
- 27 So the servants of the owner came and said to him, 'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have tares?'

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Matthew 13

- 28 He said to them, 'An enemy has done this.' The servants said to him, 'Do you want us then to go and gather them up?'
- 29 But he said, 'No, lest while you gather up the tares you also uproot the wheat with them.
- 30 Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, "First gather together the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat into my barn.""

<u>Different Seed</u>: Salvation by "faith only."

"What does the scripture say?" (Rom 4:3)

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<u>James 2:24</u>

24 You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only.

Mark 16:16

16 He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

<u>Different Seed</u>: Salvation without baptism.

"What does the scripture say?" (Rom 4:3)

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Romans 10:13

13 For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."

Acts 22:16

16 And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.'

<u>Different Seed</u>: "Once saved, always saved."

"What does the scripture say?" (Rom 4:3)

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Matthew 5:13

13 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men.

<u>Different Seed</u>: The "kingdom of God" has not come yet ... but will come soon.

"What does the scripture say?" (Rom 4:3)

Matthew 16:18-19

18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

19 And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

<u>Different Seed</u>: Women installed in leadership positions.

"What does the scripture say?" (Rom 4:3)

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1 Corinthians 14:34-35

34 Let your women keep silent in the churches, for they are not permitted to speak; but they are to be submissive, as the law also says.

35 And if they want to learn something, let them ask their own husbands at home; for it is shameful for women to speak in church.

<u>Different Seed</u>: Tampering with when & how often to observe communion.

"What does the scripture say?" (Rom 4:3)

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Acts 20:7

7 Now on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, ...

<u>Different Seed</u>: Tampering with <u>how</u> to observe communion.

- Plurality of loaves.
- Breaking the loaf.
- Fermented wine.
- Plurality of cups.

<u>Different Seed</u>: Tampering with <u>how</u> to observe communion.

"What does the scripture say?" (Rom 4:3)

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- One unbroken loaf (1 Cor 10:16-17)
- Unfermented grape juice (Mt 26:17-29)
- One cup (1 Cor 11:23-25)

<u>Different Seed</u>: Tampering with the music.

- Special singing groups.
- Mechanical instruments.

<u>Different Seed</u>: Tampering with the music.

"What does the scripture say?" (Rom 4:3)

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Ephesians 5:19

19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,

"sing"

⇒ "make music with voice"

There are not saved Christians in many churches.

- The Lord has only one church.
- There are saved Christians only in the Lord's church.

Ephesians 2:14-16

- 14 For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation,
- 15 having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace,
- 16 and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.

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
