

# 25 REASONS YOU SHOULD INVESTIGATE THE CHURCH OF CHRIST

- 1) Because it was founded by Christ Himself (Mt. 16:18).
- 2) Because it was founded upon a scriptural foundation (1 Cor. 3:11).
- 3) Because it was founded at the scriptural place – Jerusalem (Isa. 2:2-3).
- 4) Because it was founded at the scriptural time – Pentecost, following the Lord’s resurrection (Acts 2:47).
- 5) Because Christ is the founder of only one church – His church (Jn. 10:16).
- 6) Because it is scriptural in name (Rom. 16:16).
- 7) Because it is scriptural in organization (Eph. 2:20).
- 8) Because the Bible is its only “creed,” “confession of faith,” and “church manual” (2 Tim. 3:16-17).
- 9) Because it believes all the Bible to be the inspired word of God (2 Tim. 3:16-17; 2 Pet. 1:21).
- 10) Because it believes the Bible is a book to be “rightly divided” (2 Tim. 2:15; Col. 2:14; Heb. 8:13).
- 11) Because it is anti-denominational (Jn. 17:21).
- 12) Because it is scriptural in doing mission work (Mk. 16:15; Mt. 28:19).
- 13) Because it teaches the kingdom has already been established and that Christ is now reigning as “King of kings” (Mk. 9:1; Col. 1:13).
- 14) Because it gives a scriptural answer to the question, “What must I do to be saved?” (Mk. 16:16; Acts 2:38).
- 15) Because it teaches that man is saved by faith (Rom. 5:1), but not by “faith only” (Ja. 2:24).

- 16) Because it teaches man is saved by the blood of Christ (Mt. 26:28; Acts 2:38; Rom. 6:3-4).
- 17) Because it teaches that a change of heart is required for a man to be saved (Lk. 13:3).
- 18) Because it teaches that alien sinners cannot be saved by simply praying (Jn. 9:31; 1 Jn. 3:22).
- 19) Because it teaches and administers scriptural baptism (Acts 2:38; 22:16; Rom. 6:3-4; 1 Pet. 3:21).
- 20) Because it teaches that a child of God can so sin as to be eternally lost (1 Cor. 10:12; Heb. 6:4-6; 2 Pet. 2:20-22).
- 21) Because it teaches babies are born pure and innocent rather than depraved (Mt. 18:3; 19:14; Rom. 7:9).
- 22) Because it teaches that the miraculous powers of the Holy Spirit have ceased (Acts 8:18; 1 Cor. 13:8-13; Ja. 1:25)
- 23) Because of its scriptural teaching and observance of the Lord's supper (Acts 20:7; 1 Cor. 11:23-26).
- 24) Because it teaches the only acceptable music in worship today is a cappella singing (Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16).
- 25) Because salvation is in Christ's church (Acts 20:28; Eph. 5:23-25).
